## In order to change the thumbnail size and appearance settings:

- 1. Log in to the administration panel of your store.
- 2. Open the **Administration** tab.
- 3. Click on the **Settings** link.
- 4. Click on the **Thumbnails** link.
- 5. Specify the neccessary thumbnails settings.
- 6. Click on the **Save** button.

**NOTE:** After changing these settings you will need to clean up the thumbnail cache in order to re-generate the automatically created thumbnails. In order to do it open this link in your browser: <u>http://www.your\_domain.com/admin.php?ct</u> where **www.your\_domain.com** is the address of your store and where **admin.php** is a script file for the administration panel of your store that was renamed for security reasons. Before cleaning the thumbnail cache you should be logged in to the administration panel of your store.

Detailed pictures are displayed in the **View larger image** window and are stored in the **images/detailed** directory on the server, created thumbnails are displayed on the product details page and are stored in the **images/thumbnails** directory. If you add additional images for the product, additional small thumbnails are created and displayed under the main image on the product details page, they are also stored in the **images/thumbnails** directory.
