

# Displaying the 'Quantity' box as a selectbox with quantity variants

1. Log in to your administration panel, open the **Catalog** tab and click on the **Products** link.
2. Click on the product name of the desired product.
3. Set up a step of product quantity in the **Quantity step** input field. If **Quantity step** is set to 2, then only 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, etc. items will be displayed in the **Quantity** select box. And if 5 (for instance) is entered into the **In stock** input field then 2, 4 will be displayed in the **Quantity** select box.
4. Enter the number of items, 2 (for instance) in the quantity list in the **List quantity count** input field. If 7 (for instance) is entered into the **In stock** input field and 2 is set up for the **Quantity step** then only 2, 4 will be displayed in the **Quantity** select box.
